FUNERAL PLANNING

Starting a conversation with your loved ones about end of life, dying, or funeral plans can be very difficult for both you and them. Many people are ready to talk openly about death but their family are frightened (or triggered) by having to face the reality.

Writing down what you would like for your funeral or memorial service in advance can give lots of people a sense of control over their own destiny. It also takes the pressure off families to make tough and often overwhelming decisions in the midst of grief. Even if they don't want to talk about it whilst you're still alive.

Below is a list of things you may like to make decisions around or talk about with your loved ones.

IMMEDIATELY AFTER DEATH

Please give my family time to visit and say goodbye

I would like to be washed and dressed by my family

Please have my body moved to a funeral home (for burial or cremation)

Please have my body moved directly to a crematorium (for a memorial service)

Please observe the religious rituals around burial or death that are important to me
